Poinsettia Popper

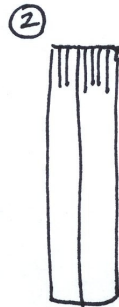
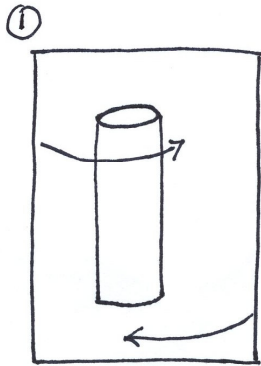
Doublette crepe paper

Popper tube

One 2 1/2" sticker

Two 12" lengths wax twine

Double sided tape

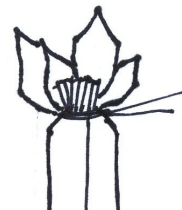
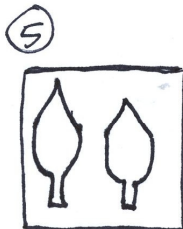
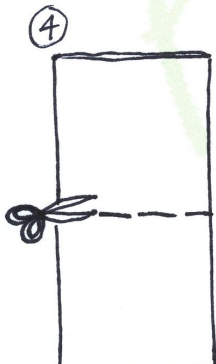


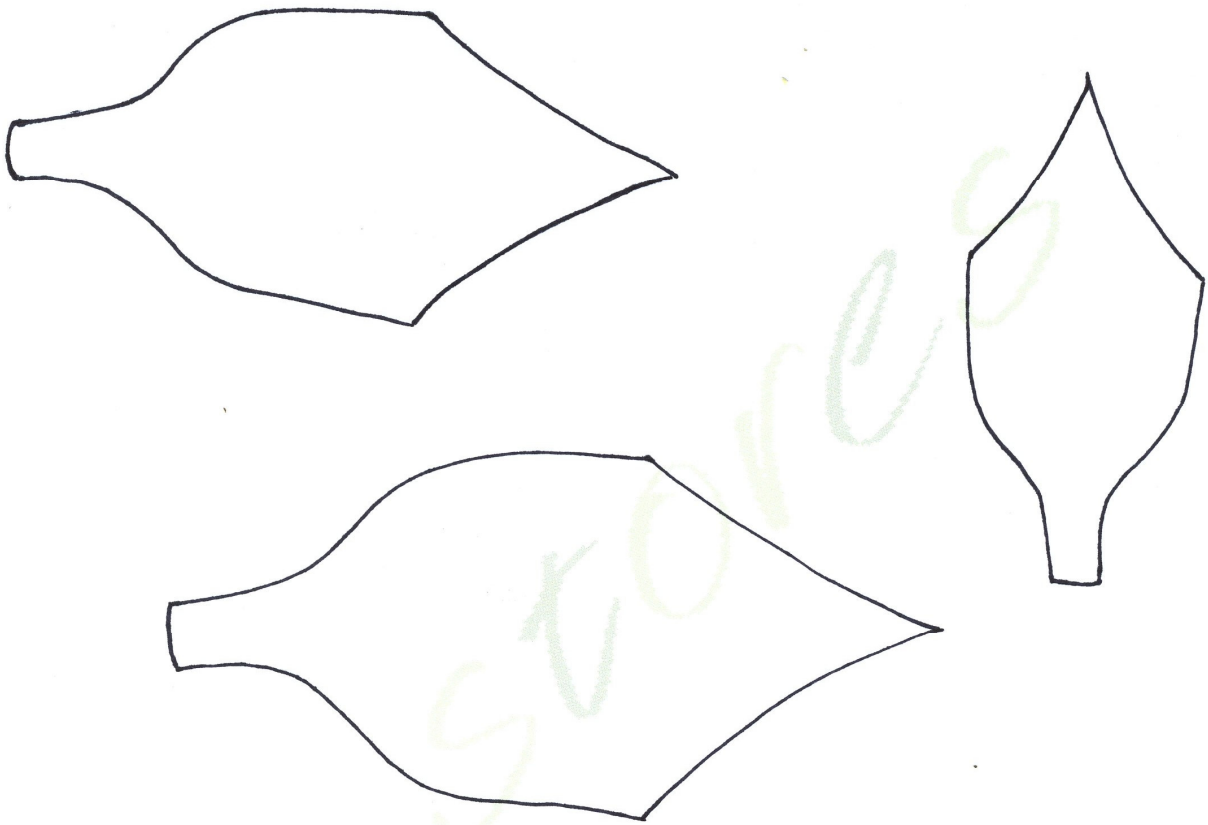
① Cut one length of crepe paper 10" x 7"
Center tube on length of crepe paper, pleat one end and finish with a sticker.

② Fringe ends to create flower stamen. Load your popper at this time with goodies. Cinch and secure with waxed twine, tie double knot and clip to knot.



③ Cut a 5" length and lay poinsettia petal template down and cut multiples petals through the layers. To assemble flower topper, select petals and wrap random sizes around the stamen center. To help keep petals in place, use a piece of double sided tape to keep in place. Secure petals with waxed twine, wrapping tightly twice with a double knot. Clip excess to knot.





As in nature, poinsettia petals are random in sizes.
So mix petal sizes as you wrap your petals around the stamen center.
